LIKE HIS POLISH astronomer namesake. Copérnicus, alias Joseph Smalkowaski, is a pioneer in his field. Though hurdened with the label avant-garde, he delies all musical classification. Startine in the late '70s with his so-called "musical mother and father." Larry Kirwin and Pierce Turner, Copernicus still remains a poet at heart, Ad-libbing against an 🗸 aural backdrop that is itself spontaneously erected, be bursts forth with bard-edged observations on the shape of

today's reality. Music and tyrics are unrehearsed, making each performance unique. Genres too are often at variance, from the jazzfunk flavor of the title track to the New Age minimalism of "Lies." to the countrified twang of "The Wanderer." The beauty of it all is that it works; words and music geliato's tight unison. Indefinable but potent.
